

How To Separate And Dispose Garbage

*Bring your waste on a collection day by 8.30 AM *Garbage Bags that are specified by the Village must be used.

*Never use any other type of plastic bags.

Combustible materials

<p>Burnable Waste</p> <p>Mondays/Thursdays</p>		<p>Do not pierce the garbage bag by bamboo skewer and fork.</p> <p>Do not put any food scraps inside the garbage bag.</p>

Noncombustible material

<p>Non-Burnable Waste</p> <p>Wednesdays</p>		<p>Hard containers such as shampoo bottles are "Non-Burnable Waste".</p> <p>Do not put small electric appliances, shoes and clothes inside the garbage bag. (It is oversized garbage)</p>

Recyclable Garbage

<p>Other Plastic Products</p> <p>Tuesdays</p>		<p>Rinse inside.</p> <p>If they are dirty, dispose as burnable waste.</p>

<p>PET bottles</p> <p>Wednesdays</p>		<p>Take the cap off. Caps should be disposed separately.</p> <p>Rinse the inside.</p> <p>Crush it.</p>

<p>Cans/Metal Waste</p> <p>Tuesdays</p>		<p>Dispose aluminium and steel cans separately.</p> <p>Make sure to pierce spray cans and gas cylinders before disposal.</p>

<p>Bottles</p> <p>Fridays</p>		<p>Bottles should be rinsed and sorted out by colors. They should be put into separate bags.</p> <p>Put the metal cap into "Metal Waste".</p>

Recyclable Garbage (Bring to community center)

<p>Waste Papers</p> <p>Last Sundays of the month</p>		<p>Newspapers, magazines, and cardboard only.</p>

Noncombustible material

<p>Toxic waste</p> <p>At any time</p>		<p>Put fluorescent lamp and light bulb in the protective cardboard.</p>

<p>Oversized garbage</p> <p>Items are collected on the second and the fourth Saturday of every month</p>		<p>The collection of oversized garbage will incur charges.</p> <p>On the second Saturday, we will collect at the Village office car park and on the fourth Saturday we will collect at the Clean center. For details, please consult directly with your employer.</p>

<p>About kitchen garbage</p>	<p>Do not put any food scraps in the garbage bag.</p> <p>Check with your employer how to dispose of food scraps.</p>
