How To Separate And Dispose Garbage

*Bring your waste on a collection day by 8.30 AM *Garbage Bags that are specified by the Village must be used.

*Never use any other type of plastic bags.

Combustible materials

Burnable Waste

Do not pierce the garbage bag by bamboo skewer and fork.

Do not put any food scraps inside the garbage bag

Noncombustible material

Non-Burnable Waste

Wednesdays









Hard containers such as shampoo bottles are "Non-Burnable Waste".

Do not put small electric appliances, shoes and clothes inside the garbage bag. (It is oversized garbage)

Rinse inside.



Dispose aluminium and steel cans separate-


Make sure to pierce spray cans and gas cylinders before disposal.
